2022-2023 COVID-19 School Operations Plan

Instruction

Magoffin County Schools will be offering two learning options for families during the 2022-2023 school year.

1. In-Person Instruction – Students will attend school five days per week beginning August 10, 2022.
2. Virtual Learning – K - 12 students have had the option to sign up and participate in the Magoffin County Virtual Academy. Enrollment in the virtual academy must continue for at least one semester. While the program is totally online, student progress/attendance will be monitored and assistance will be provided by the school district.

Covid-19 Protocols

1. Magoffin County Schools will remain mask optional for students, staff, and guests. Masking will not be required in any school buildings or on buses.
2. If students or staff members test positive for COVID-19, they should self-isolate for at least 5 days from the day that their symptoms started, or 5 full days from the date of testing if they have never developed symptoms. The individual may return to school after 5 days when their symptoms have fully resolved, followed by wearing a mask for 5 days.
3. Physical distancing is not routinely recommended but should be considered after COVID-19 exposures, during outbreaks or for high-risk persons.
4. Contact tracing following school exposures to COVID-19 is not expected.
5. Everyone who is known to have had close contact to a person with COVID-19 is recommended to be tested 5 days or more after the exposure.
6. Quarantine is not routinely recommended following exposures to COVID-19 for people without symptoms.

Athletics/Extra-Curricular Activities

1. Magoffin County Schools will follow guidance from the Kentucky High School Athletic Association (KHSAA) concerning all athletic practices and events. Additionally, guidance in this return plan applies to all athletic and extra-curricular activities.

Attendance

1. Policies and procedures regarding Covid-19-related absences (students and staff) will correspond with policies and procedures for traditional health-related absences.
